






The Macon Telegraph Publishing Company does not consent to the use of The Macon News in connection with the publication tributed by the United have not used for years. Nuwaupian Nation of Moors, and will not consent to the use of this name by any other person, firm, or corporation." (Although we support their endeavors, we are not the United Nuwaupian Nation of Moors, so they were writing to the wrong people). The letter also states that the use of this trademark does not expire until August 18, 2003 A.D.

According to the American Heritage Dictionary, "trademark" is defined as "a name,

symbol, or other device identifying a product, officially registered, and legally restricted to the use of the owner or manufacturer." When you look at the front cover of any newspaper, usually the "trademark" is right there. It is either a symbol that is always used, or the name of the paper. Was Rep. Cynthia McKinney really wrong?

Recent developments in U.S. foreign policy have beckoned Rep. Cynthia McKinney, D-Ga., into the limelight. McKinney, a member of the International Relations Committee, is speaking out about the denial of overtime pay to American military, the war in Afghanistan and the budgetary provisions for development assistance to sub-Saharan Africa. The most notable is her disapproval of New York City Mayor Rudolph Giuliani's decision to decline a \$10 million donation to the victims and victims' families of the Sept. 11, 2001 AD. attack on the World Trade Center.

Giuliani accepted the donation, offered by Saudi Arabian Prince Alwaleed Bin Talal, before the prince made a comment about U.S. foreign policy being partly to blame for the attacks. "At times like this one, we must address some of the issues that led to such a criminal attack," the Prince said in a written statement distributed by his publicist. "I believe the government of the United States of America should re-examine its policies in the Middle East and adopt a more balanced stance toward the Palestinian cause."

Giuliani, who had attended a memorial service with Bin Talal and accepted his \$10-million offer to help victims' families, had a harsh response when he learned about the statement. "There is no moral equivalent for this attack," Giuliani said. "The people who did it lost any right to ask for jus-



tification when they slaughtered 5,000-6,000 innocent people. Not only are those statements wrong, they're part of the problem." Giuliani returned the prince's check.

McKinney disagreed with Giuliani's actions and wrote a letter of apology to Bin Talal. "I was disappointed that Mayor Giuliani chose to decline your generous offer and instead criticize you for your observations of events in the Middle East," she wrote. "Whether he agreed with you or not, I think he should have recognized your right to speak and make observations about a part of the world which you know so well."

She then asked Bin Talal to consider donating the money to organizations that help Americans in need, predominately Blacks. McKinney explained to the prince the state of most Blacks in

America as being one of desperation, poverty and seclusion from mainstream America. "Although your offer was not accepted by Mayor Giuliani, I would like to ask you to consider assisting Americans who are in dire need right now. I believe we can guide your generosity to help improve the state of Black America and build better lives," she wrote.

McKinney has come under great scrutiny as a result of this letter, but was she really wrong? In response to Mckinney's touts that White America does not want to listen to what Blacks have to say about foreign policy, an online columnist with National Review Online called them moronic. "Then she needs to explain why I keep finding these quotes in my morning paper by Condoleezza Rice and Colin Powell," he said.

Cynthia Tucker, editor of The Atlanta Journal Constitution's editorial page, encouraged McKinney to take a trip to Saudi Arabia where the "women are treated like chattel," and where human rights abuses abound. McKinney defended herself and says she did not surrender her right to speak out when she voted for the War Powers Resolution. Victims and victims' families from the Sept. 11, 2001 A.D. attack are still in need, she said. "The Bergen County (NJ) Record reports today that only 1,496 checks have been distributed to families in need, leaving too many of the families of the police officers, firemen, other rescue workers and other victims still unhelped." Giuliani is well aware of how much the funds were needed, or else he would have never accepted the money in the first place; however, he let one comment and his pride lead to the continuous suffering of thousands of families.

McKinney also said any money appropriated by Congress or distributed by insurance companies will not be enough to replace those lost. "With that having been said, my point was simply that the \$10 million donation should have been accepted whether or not we, as Americans, agree with every position taken by the prince." It seems many who chastised McKinney did not look at the big picture.

McKinney represents Georgia's Fourth District, which is one of the most ethnically diverse districts in the southeastern United States. The district comprises parts of DeKalb and Gwinnett Counties

and the city council isn't using theirs? Councilman Jim Lee proposed the restrictions on the cards to prevent the possibility of misusing tax dollars and to save the city funds. The council has admitted that the Mayor has not abused any of his credit card privileges. Lee says, "I have no reason to question his honesty". This ordinance could, with another council vote strip the Mayor of his city card privileges and subject him to public censure. The mayor says he has all his receipts and says that he hasn't abused any privileges.



Police stood guard on Sept. 17, 2001 A.D. at the Capitol Hill office of Congresswoman Barbara Lee, the target of threats after casting the sole vote against the use of military

force in response to the attacks on September

Plainclothes Capitol officers first took up posts in her legislative office Saturday morning, hours after she became the only member of either House of Representatives Senate to oppose a military retort to the attacks.

'People are grieving, people are angry and frustrated. I understand that emotions are running high," said Lee (D-California),

saying she has been personally talking to some callers and trying to answer as many of the thousands of e-mails that have swamped her office as she can.

She would not specify the threats, but said the reaction began to pour in instantly after she cast her

"I'm as patriotic as they are and as American as they are," she said of the callers. "When I talk to them,

they understand that Congress has to add its voice to this, too.

I really believe Congress should step back, use restraint and make sure our response does not allow the cycle of violence to sprawl out of control," she said.

A spokesman for Capitol police refused to discuss the

threats or how long the added protection would continue.

resolution, which authorized the use of force President Bush response to the terror massacre, passed 98-80 in the Senate and 420-1 in the House.

The vote was not out of character for Lee, who criticized former President Bill Clinton's bombing campaign against Iraq in 1998 A.D. and was the only House mem-

ber to vote against a March 1999 A.D. resolution authorizing support for U.S. troops in the Balkans.

Her stances have not hurt her at home in California, where she represents the liberal outposts of Oakland and Berkeley.

"I really want people to understand," Lee said. "I struggled, I agonized. This is a confusing time. We have to make sure we ask all the right questions." right questions.'

Bin Laden - the next boogieman

If you look through American history, America has always created a boogieman, a terrifying specter. Here is a list of the most famous: Fidel Castro, Idi Amin, Ayottalah Ruhollah Khomeini, Qaddafi Muammar, Manuel Antonio Noriega Moreno and Saddam Hussein. Now it is Osama Bin Laden- all of them except Castro are Mohemmedans.

In 1956 A.D. Cuban revolutionary Fidel Castro ousted Cuban dictator Fulgencio Batista. Batista fled the island on January 1, 1959 A.D., and Fidel Castro emerged as the leader of the new government in Cuba. Fidel Castro's

opposition to U.S. influence in Cuba and other parts of the world made conflict between the two nations inevitable. Fidel Castro chose international confrontation with the United States as his defining international principle.

Idi Amin was the commander of Uganda's armed forces when he overthrew the country's civilian government in 1971 A.D. A Tanzanian invasion, supported by Ugandan rebels, forced Idi Amin's exile from the country in 1979 A.D. Idi Amin was condemned by much of the international community for his brutality, but when Britain and the United States cut aid to Uganda in 1972 A.D., he successfully turned to Libya and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics (USSR). Idi Amin's rule led to low regard for human life and personal security, widespread corruption, and the disturbance of economic production and allocation.

Ayottalah Ruhollah Khomeini was a religious leader who, from exile, led the popular revolution that toppled Muhammad Reza Shah Pahlavi of Iran in 1979 A.D. Like many Iranians, Ayottalah Khomeini was angered by the interference of foreign powers in Iran. In the early 1960s A.D., the shah proclaimed a White Revolution in which he introduced many Western ideas. From his Faziye Seminary in Qom, Ayottalah Khomeini vehemently attacked the Shah's policies, prompting the shah to imprison him in 1963 A.D. and expel him from Iran in 1964 A.D. Ayottalah Khomeini settled in An Najaf, where he forged his doctrine of the "Rule of the Jurist," which called for the clergy to govern. From An Najaf and later from Paris, where he lived after 1978 A.D.,



Osama Bin Laden Wanted Dead or Alive

Ayottalah Khomeini urged Iranians to topple the Shah and his American allies, who he claimed were "robbing us of our brains." When the Shah was finally overthrown and forced to flee the country in January 1979 A.D., Ayottalah Khomeini returned to Iran and a new constitution was passed declaring Iran an Islamic republic, and Ayottalah Khomeini was named imam (a successor Muhammad), and supreme leader for life.

Muammar Qaddafi was a Libyan revolutionary leader and strongman, known for his devotion to Islam and his passionate support for pan-Arabic and revolutionary causes. In 1969 A.D., then a captain, Muammar Qaddafi led a coup that deposed King Idris I and proclaimed

Libya an Arab republic. As chairman of the Revolutionary Command Council, he acquired dictatorial powers. He used Libya's vast oil wealth to support Palestinian guerrillas against Israel; he also aided other insurrectional and terrorist groups, from Philippine Muslim rebels to the Irish Republican Army. He promoted various fruitless schemes for merging Libya with other

In 1983 A.D., Manuel Antonio Noriega became head of the National Guard and promoted himself to general to gain efficient control of Panama's government. In 1986 A.D., allegations emerged that Manuel Antonio Noriega was involved in drug trafficking, money laundering, and acting as a double agent for both the United States Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) and Cuba's intelligence agency. In December 1989 A.D., U.S. forces invaded Panama, and arrested Manuel Antonio Noriega, who was taken to Florida to stand trial. In April 1992 A.D., Manuel Antonio Noriega was found guilty of cocaine trafficing, racketeering, and money laundering, marking the first time in history that a U.S. jury had convicted a foreign head of state of criminal charges.

Saddam Hussein, authoritarian president of Iraq since 1979 A.D., led his country into two devastating wars. Despite that, Saddam Hussein succeeded in facing down all internal challenges to his rule. In the late 1990s A.D., Saddam Hussein periodically brought Iraq to the brink of further military conflicts by refusing to comply with United Nations inspection teams assigned to ensure that Iraq had destroyed its nuclear, biological, and chemical

seems to be targeting big cities like New York, Florida,

Washington, and people are shutting down everything: government office buildings, post offices, businesses, etc. Having to close important offices that run the city has caused a real catastrophe. This is not to be taken lightly, unlike most cases; it is spreading all over the place. You are in danger by any mail you open, and you can't do anything about it. By the time you get it, it's too late. Also, there is no proof that Anthrax is Arab related. In fact, investigation is more so proving it to be domestic. The bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City in 1995 A.D. was domestic. Are we dealing with White American militia groups in-house terrorists? We're being trained to look at Middle Eastern and Arabs as the devil, Timothy McVeigh was not of Middle Eastern descent, he was a Christian. Theodore John Kaczynski, the "Unabomber" killed three people and injured 23 others in a 17-year bombing campaign against industry, academia, and the airlines. He was not of Middle Eastern descent either. We are forgetting that terrorism is on our soil. So Americans, we must be on our

According to the definition of terrorism, the Mafia could be called terrorists. They kill 6,000 people daily with drugs, and are responsible for thousands of deaths and unsolved murders. The group of doctors, dentists and surgeons are also responsible for killing thousands everyday with legal drugs. There are countless numbers of malpractice suits where people have died because of a mistake that a doctor made. Check the lawsuits. Doctors told Lisa Woodall of Athens that she had an ulcer, when she started having pains in her abdomen. However, she was really suffering from gallstones in her gallbladder, and eventually had to have her gallbladder removed. If the problem would have been caught sooner, Woodall could still have her gallbladder. Mr. Richardson of Putnam County underwent major surgery, and the surgeon left a sponge inside of his body when stitching him up. He later died due to complications because of this carelessness.

Let's look at motor vehicles, and those who manufacture automobiles. They put a range from 80-235 mph on the speedometer, selling high-speed cars, when the speed limit in most cities does not exceed 70 mph. Thousands of people die everyday in car crashes alone. This is demolition, which is another form of terrorism. In September, eight athletes from the University of Wyoming were killed in a truck collision. Everyday men, women and children die in automobile accidents.

Violent events are given much more media coverage than peaceful events. The industry of terrorism is programmed through movie coverage and contributes to acts of terrorism by our youth, as in Columbine (the idea directly influenced from the movie Baseball Diaries). How many kids die gang-related deaths that they don't put on TV. Thousands of kids die because of media terrorism. Let's not forget cigarettes, alcohol, and activities such as bungee jumping - we've heard about those casu-

Kaye Redding, a mother whose son is in the army says, "Isn't our country a form of terrorism if they put our sons in suits and send them to die?" U.S. Catholic Bishop picked as first Black leader

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops on Tuesday elected Bishop Wilton Gregory of Illinois as its president - the first Black man to hold the position.

Gregory, 53, has led the Belleville, Illinois, diocese since 1994 A.D. He has written extensively on issues

such as the death penalty and euthanasia.

Immediately upon Gregory's election, calls of delight from across the country poured in to the bishops' conference, curmeeting rently Washington.

"You have remember, in the earlier part of the 1800s A.D. no one would even ordain a Black man to be a priest," said Beverly Carroll, executive director of the bishops conference's American Catholics.

"To go from that to electing someone to the highest office in the United States? It means so much - especially for our older Black Catholics. They thought they would never live to see a Black man lead the U.S. bishops.'

An estimated 2 million African-Americans (7% of the nation's Blacks) are Catholic, including about 350 priests. Of the church's 200 U.S. bishops, 13 are Black, Carroll said. Gregory, a Chicago native, was ordained in 1973 A.D. after completing studies at St. Mary of the Lake Seminary. He earned a doctorate in sacred liturgy at the Pontifical Liturgical Institute in Rome. He is widely regarded as personable and accessible as well as an outstanding administrator.

"This tells the wider church that we have people who are qualified, who are experienced, to move into high-level positions," said Hilbert Stanley, director of the Baltimore-based National Black Catholic

In recent years, Blacks in the clergy have worked to convince Black people that they are welcome in the church, and urged the church to become more cultur-





Retina, stimulates the optic nerve, letting those with retinal damage see light.





His doctors say that due to a previous problem of a bleeding stomach, which prevented surgeons from giving him drugs that inhibit blood clots most of his time in the hospital. "A patient with an artificial heart valve needs blood thinning, or he will have a stroke." Dowling said. He's presently recovering. Miracles of God's grace



Roger McMillan, her boyfriend, received a call from her right after the first blast, telling him that she was at her desk and was instructed to stay there by the loud speaker. He

could see the explosion from his job, he told her to get out and meet him in front of Century 21, a department store across from the Trade Center.

Roger walked and ran some 20 blocks. Passing by injured survivors, plane parts and debris. front of the store and there was a mountain debris. He searched for her; finally he called his voice mail. His girlfriend Genelle had called him saying that she was going to stay at her job. "I lost all hope when I heard that, " he

building had collapsed. She worked on the 13th floor. Her head was caught between two pillars suffering for hours. She could feel a man trapped close to her, so she pushed closer to him for comfort. He cried out twice, then eventually fell silent. She talked repeatedly with God, asking God, "Please give me a second chance at life. Then saying another prayer, "Please give me this one miracle." All she could see was darkness, then a man appeared and carried her from the debris. She was there uncertain if she was going to live or die for twenty-six hours.

Recovering at Bellevue Hospital, Genelle is one of five survivors found at the Trade Center after the day of the attack. The couple says that, "Before, we went to church on a couple of occasions, it's something you put off." But Genelle says from her hospital bed, "This is her calling to God." They are now

talking about plans to marry.

Arriving early to work this morning Nishikant Kapatker and his wife Jaya were going to go on vacation that evening. The impact of Flight 11, threw him from his chair and he quickly went to the stairwell and proceeded down the stairs. Watching as he went down, 20 or 30 fire fighters making their way up the stairs huffing and puffing to their unknowing fate ahead. As he exited the plaza, he saw the body parts all over the plaza. He was looking for his wife, but the building she worked in had been evacuated. It was close to 11 a.m. when she was finally spotted. "She was sitting on a bench all alone, her head down," he says. She was praying and meditating. Nishikant put his hand on Jaya's shoulder. "And she cried like a baby for a long time." A

There are many other people who were fortunate enough to experience the wonders of God's grace. That have happened from the Scriptural recordings of time till now and I'm certain many more will be seen. In times of adversity, it seems that miracles are noticed more, however, we can see by the birth of babies into this world everyday that miracles of God are occurring more often than we think.



Al Mahdi did purchase Al Sihal




U.N. Secretary-General Kofi Annan and the **United Nations receive Nobel Peace Prize**

Secretary-General Kofi Annan was given the Nobel Peace Prize along with the United Nations for their unified efforts to make a "more peaceful world." Annan was born in Kumasi, Ghana. His father was a provincial governor in Ghana and a Fante tribal chief. Annan, devoted about half of his entire working life to the United Nations, praised for "bringing new life to the organization," that has many times taken great risks in the furtherance of human rights and resolving conflicts since the end of World War

The United Nations founded in 1945 A.D. by 51 nations, created in the aftermath of World War II as a shellshocked world's hoped for peace, the United Nations has almost quadrupled in membership and more diverse. It now employs about 52,100 people at the U.N. headquarters in New York and 29 other organizations spread around the globe and is still the sole global meeting assembly for nations rich and poor, large and small work out international problems.

He joined the United Nations in 1962 A.D. as an administrator with the World Health Organization in Geneva. His U.N. career has been incredibly varied with posts in Africa and Europe in almost every area of the organiza-

tion, from budget management to the head of U.N. peacekeeping. Kofi Annan has risen to new challenges such as HIV/AIDS and international terrorism, and brought about more effective application of the U.N.'s modest resources. Kofi Annan and the United Nations divide the \$943,000 awarded equally.

The Nobel Peace Prize committee admirably noticed Annan and appreciated the noble work and silent suffering of the U.N. In very much the same character and altruistic manner as that of the other six Nobel Peace Prize laureates endured to deserve their awards.

The Secretary General happens to be the seventh Black person internationally to receive the Nobel Peace Prize. The following are the six international Black recipients of the prizes inception



Ralph J. Bunche

1) 1950 -Ralph Johnson Bunche 1904-1971 A.D., he was head of the Office Strategic Services from 1941 to 1944 A.D. in the federal government,

during World War II, and joined the United States Department of State in 1944 A.D.; in 1945 A.D. An expert on trusteeship issues in the United Nations, he participated in the writing of the UN Charter. His skill as a mediator awarded him, the first African American to receive the 1950 Nobel Peace Prize after negotiating the agreements that halted the 1948-1949 Arab-Israeli War. For 22 years he served on the board of the NAACP, earning its highest honour, the Spingarn Medal in 1949 A.D. He too

Washington. 2) 1960 -Albert John Luthuli 1898-1967 A.D., a South African civil rights and political leader who for his preserving dedication to a

Entertainers get caught up



Two best selling singles were included on the set, "Sex Me (Parts I & II)" and "Bump 'N Grind." These songs were known for their high sexual content. Before his next album in 1997 A.D., Kelly found God and got caught up. It abstained from the blatant sexuality of 12 Play, attributed in part to his friendship with gospel singer Kirk Franklin. "I used to be flying in sin - now I'm

flying with Jesus," said Kelly.

called Ministry of Women of God on Eleventh Street. Now referred to as Sister Perri Reid, she was a singer, songwriter and a producer and manager of the female group TLC. In November 1997 A.D., Reid says she had an occurrence with God that changed her life. Although she wasn't raised in church, didn't know the Bible, any gospel hymns or even how to pray, Reid says God sent her messages and now she preaches with power. "I am a walking testimony,"

After years as a backslider, Hammer says he's rededicated his life to Jesus. He was known in the music business for selling more than 25 million albums worldwide. His tributes include three Grammy's, seven American Music Awards and two MTV Awards. Despite his fame, Hammer faded from view a little over ten years ago. Now, Hammer is back, and this time he says Jesus is with him. What many don't know is that

Hammer started out doing gospel and was very committed to God in 1984 A.D. It was the fame of the secular songs in 1988 A.D. that made him slowly turn away. Hammer says, "You create a utopia around you so you don't have to deal with the reality that you're not in the will of God. You wake up and realize that you're a backslider." About four years ago, Hammer decided to allow the Spirit to lead him once again, and he is now an evangelist. He debuted at the World Gospel '97 extravaganza, singing about his new devotion to God and being caught up.

Once called the future of hip-hop, ex-rapper Mase made an announcement in 1999 A.D. that he was retiring from rap to follow God. 

Clemens and Mariano Rivera showed they know a little bit about pitching in the World Series, also. Clemens won when the Yankees couldn't afford to lose, shutting down Arizona over seven innings for a 2-1 victory Tuesday night, October 30, that cut the Diamondbacks' lead to two games-to-one.

Baseball fans, meet the first Mr. November Derek Jeter. The Yankees star earned that distinction at 12:04 a.m. EST Thursday, November 1, hitting a home run with two outs

in the bottom of 10th inning to lift New York past the Arizona Diamondbacks 4-3 and tie the World Series at two games each. Tino Martinez saved the Yankees with a two-out, two-run homer in the ninth off closer Byung-Hyun Kim.

Once was incredible; twice was too hard to believe. The Yankees beat the Arizona Diamondbacks 3-2 in a 12-inning Game 5 that spilled into early Friday, November 2. Scott Brosius saved the Yankees with a two-out, two-run homer in the ninth, and then Alfonso Soriano singled home the winning run to give New York a three games-to-two edge.

The Macon Whoopee has had a great start to the 2001-2002 A.D. season and even recent losses haven't put a damper on their spirits.

Head coach Gord Dineen hopes that the Whoopee will use the loss to help it refocus mentally.

"That's what got us our wins," he said. "We have to outwork and outsmart other teams."

Even without putting together a complete game on the ice, the Whoopee has still been able to maintain the ability to come out with a win when they need it.

This year's team includes some frontline changes and brought in a new goaltender that will only keep the Whoopee on top the remainder of the season

Veteran forwards Travis Brigley, David Brosseau, and Nic Beaudoin signed on to the team in early October.

The 6-foot-1-inch, 200-pound Brigley was a second-round draft choice, 39th overall, of the Calgary Flames in the 1996 National Hockey League Draft. The 24-year-old native of Coronation, Alberta, has played 274 of his 290 career professional games in the NHL, American Hockey League, and International Hockey League, scoring 57 goals and 86 assists in those contests. Last season at Louisville, Brigley tallied 14 goals and 21 assists in 49 games.

The 25-year-old Brosseau, has also seen time in the NHL, AHL and IHL. The 6-1, 200-pounder from Laval, Quebec, has enjoyed great success in the East Coast Hockey League, scoring 110 goals in 205 career games with the Charlotte Checkers. Brosseau also racked up 85 goals in two seasons with the Austin Ice Bats of the Western Professional Hockey League, including last year's 36- goal, 31-assist effort.

Beaudoin, 24, hails from Ottawa,



Ontario, and has played in the AHL with Hershey Bears, Lowell Lock Monsters, and Springfield Falcons. The 6-1, 205-pounder split last season between the United Hockey League's Mohawk Valley Prowlers and the ECHL's Arkansas RiverBlades, scoring a total of 25 goals and 31 assists.

In addition to these power forwards, Macon has brought on goalie Andrew Allen, who was assigned to the Whoopee from Hershey in the AHL.

As of October 31, however, Allen still wasn't officially on the roster. Dayton still owns Allen's ECHL rights from last season and wants some sort of compensation, which was being worked out.

"I feel really confident about our goaltending," Dineen said. "Chris Madden was something of an unknown when we first got him and he's established himself as a top goalie. (Allen) is highly touted."

"I look at the types of teams we were playing, and those were some pretty big games," Dineen said. "I thought we needed a little more experience in goal."

Though Allen has been assigned to Macon by Florida, the Panthers aren't dictating what sort of playing time he should get.

"They don't tell me how to play a guy," Dineen said. "Obviously, they want their prospects to develop and they hope he gets as many starts as he can."

and president between the years 1970 to 1981 A.D. Best remembered for his work toward peace in the Middle East, he became one of the first Arab leaders to recognize Israel. Under Sadat's leadership Egypt had proven that Israeli forces could be defeated in their attempts to take control of already governed lands. His initiative and brilliant negotiation skills led to the 1979 A.D. Egyptian Israeli Treaty and the gradual withdrawal by Israel from the entire Sinai Peninsula. For Sadat's peace negotiation he was jointly awarded the 1978 Nobel Peace Prize.

5) 1984 -Desmond Mpilo Tutu 1931 born A.D., a South African clergycivil man, rights activist and an honoured Nobel recipient. 1984 A.D. Tutu

Tutu is an ordained Anglican priest, served as bishop of Johannesburg, Lesotho, and he became the first black general secretary of the South African Council of Churches. Mandela signed into law a new South African constitution. The constitution established a federal system with a strong central government based on majority rule, and it contained guarantees of the rights of minorities and of freedom of expression.







So I don't mind sounding crazy because when you are gifted with the gift of prophecy you are always in good company." 1Corinthians 14:31 says, "For ye may all prophesy one by one, that all may learn, and all may be comforted."

"Many people are going to die this year. But that is not a prophecy, that's reality. Many jobs will be lost. Another disease is going to rise. 


